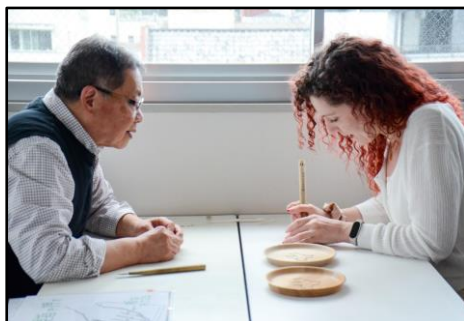

Overview

Rent out the Kamakurabori Assembly Hall and learn about the 800-year-old Kamakura Style wood carving with direct guidance from a craftsman. You will carve your own intricate piece by tracing a traditional Kamakura pattern outline, and the craftsman will later finish the carving and layer it with urushi lacquer. It will be sent to your home at a later date (can take 4 months or more).

Note: If you want to carve the entire pattern by yourself, it is possible to stay for up to 5-6 hours.

- You will rent out the assembly hall, so you can carve in peace and quiet.
- A genuine Kamakura-bori carving craftsman will be your instructor, and special wooden materials will be prepared for this craft.
- Your completely unique work will be sent to your home to use for a lifetime.

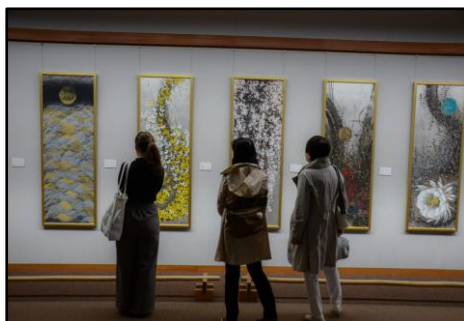

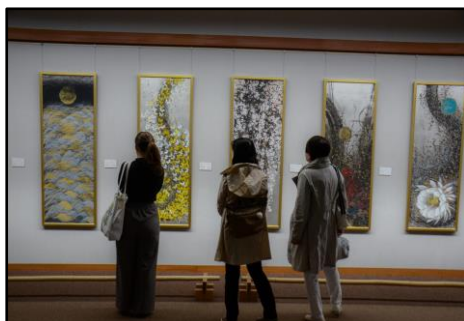
